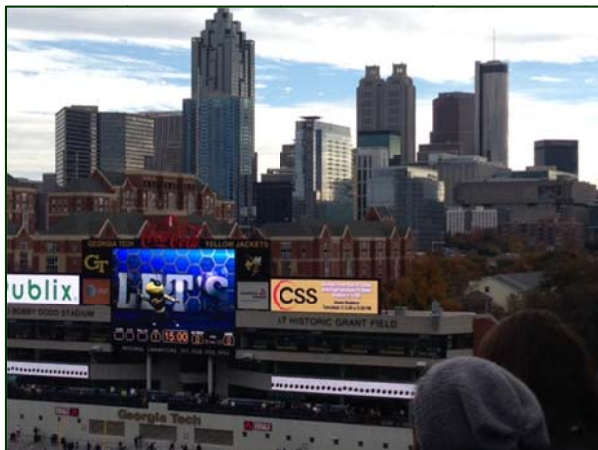

came out to support Angelique and her team. The Jackets’ 66-7 victory over the Bulldogs was beyond belief.



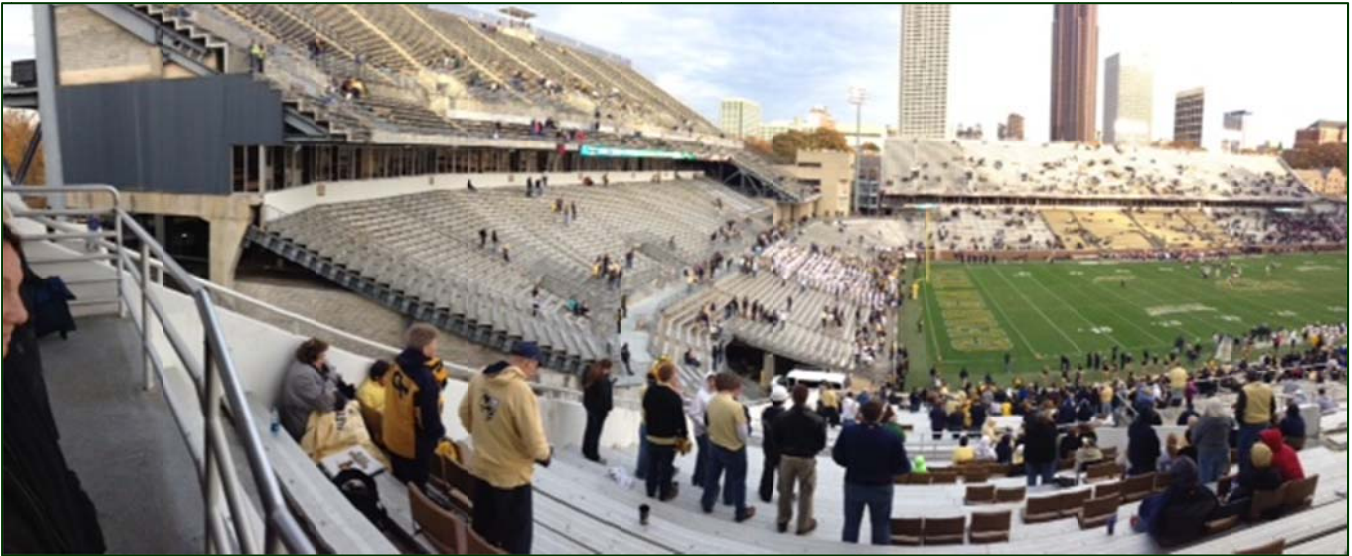

Half-time performances by Bulldogs' (above) and Jackets' (right) Marching Bands.

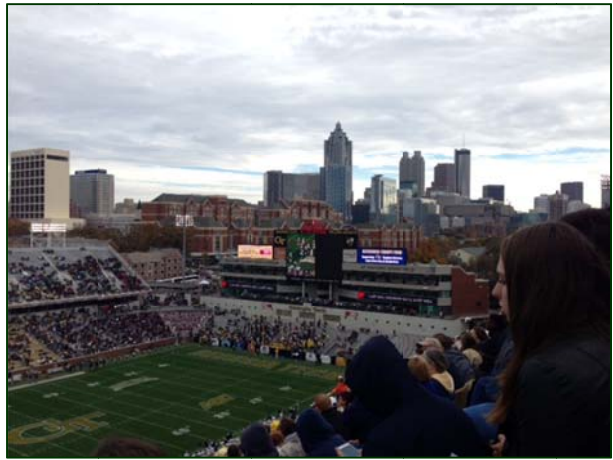


Angelique is on 35 yard line in photo on the right! *Look closely to find her!*
